'Just Accepted' feature at <http://www.atypon-link.com/WDG/loi/bchm>

The publishers and editors of *Biological Chemistry* are glad to announce that the journal is now publishing accepted papers electronically in advance of their appearance in the printed edition. *Biol Chem* 'Just Accepted' papers are accessible online soon after final acceptance on the journal's online content site at <http://www.atypon-link.com/WDG/loi/bchm>. These 'Just Accepted' articles have been peer-reviewed, accepted for publication and are published online in manuscript form prior to copyediting and typesetting. *Biol Chem* 'Just Accepted' papers are citable; the online publication date is indicated on the online Table of Contents page, and the article's Digital Object Identifier (DOI), a unique identifier for intellectual property in the digital environment, is indicated in the online header and the top margin of the article's title page. When papers do appear in print, they are removed from the 'Just Accepted' online directory and grouped with other papers in a regular journal

issue. It is planned to make the 'Just Accepted' articles retrievable from the PubMed database in the future.

With the implementation of the 'Just Accepted' publication feature, *Biol Chem* meets the requirement of the biomedical scientific community to make research results available as soon as possible after acceptance by journal editors. However, readers should be aware that the 'Just Accepted' papers have not yet gone through the full quality control process prior to advance online publication; there may be small deviations between an article published as a 'Just Accepted' paper and the final print and online version. However, even with this limitation we are confident that this new feature will aid in maintaining *Biol Chem* as a high-quality publication of significant interest to a wide life science audience.
