Check list of general points for preparation of manuscripts

General

- ✓ All parts of the manuscript should be typed using double-spacing and 12-point type.
- ✓ Do not use block capitals.
- ✓ Use SI units only.
- ✓ Capitalize and abbreviate the word “equation” when referring to specific formulas in the text. Example: Eq. (1).
- ✓ Number each section and subsection: 1., 1.1., 1.1.1. But number equations continuously from the beginning to the end of the manuscript.
- ✓ Please have your manuscript proof-read by an English native speaker.
- ✓ Use either British or American English, but be consistent.

Title page

- ✓ A short condensed running title should be given once on the first page.
- ✓ Please provide full names and institutional affiliation of all authors.
- ✓ Please add a short abstract summarizing the nature and the range of the results contained in the paper.
- ✓ Full postal addresses of all authors should appear at the beginning of the manuscript. Please use English for the institutional affiliations where possible. Note the corresponding author with an asterisk and give an e-mail address.

References

- ✓ The references in the text should be indicated by using Arabic numerals in square brackets.
- ✓ The references should be in numerical order through the text.

- ✓ Please check that all citations mentioned in the text are contained in the section References.
- ✓ Please check that all citations contained in the section References are mentioned in the text.

Tables

- ✓ Each table should be on a separate sheet.
- ✓ Headings should appear above the tables.
- ✓ No vertical framing lines in the table.
- ✓ Avoid block capitals, bold or italic text in tables.

Figures

- ✓ Each figure should be on a separate sheet, not embedded in the text.
- ✓ Where possible, figures will be reduced to a width of 8.1 cm. Therefore, all figures and lettering within the figures should be clearly drawn and big enough for reduction (but not bold) (at least 1.5 mm after reduction). Check that the symbols, projected lines and lines for axes are dark enough and in proportion to the rest of the figure.
- ✓ The lettering should be in Times font as far as possible, and should be uniform in style and size for all figures.
- ✓ Label each axis with the parameter or variable being measured, the units of measure in parentheses and the scale. Use initial capital letters only, not all capitals: Time (min), Reaction temperature (°C).
- ✓ When drawing bar graphs, use patterning instead of gray scale for better contrast.
- ✓ For photographs, use a minimum of 600 dpi for the final version. Lower resolution may be used in your initial submission.
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- ✓ To partially offset the cost of production, color figures will be printed with the following charges to the author: €600.- for the first and €300.- for each subsequent color figure in one article. The total cost for color figures will be reduced if several color illustrations appear on one printed page.
