

Instructions for authors

1. Submitting an article for publication

Manuscripts of articles should be in English. Authors whose native language is not English are asked to have their article carefully checked by a native speaker. Send **one hard copy** (including name, affiliation, and contact information) to:

In addition, please send an email with, as **attachments**, an anonymous electronic version in one file as well as an anonymous abstract (max. 200 words) in a separate file to: the.linguistic.review@uconn.edu, both as PDF files.

2. Peer review

The journal operates a double-blind peer review that usually takes 4 months. Submissions are sent to at least 2 reviewers.

3. Formatting and style

Once accepted for publication, authors are requested to submit the final version in the form of **two hard copies** sent to the Editor-in-Chief and, in addition, **an attachment** (non-PDF), conforming to journal style. If possible, one of the common word-processing systems or L^AT_EX should be used.

Any special characters used should be labelled in one of the hard copies and clearly identified at their first occurrence. The Editor-in-Chief reserves the right to reject any articles that do not conform to the requirements.

4. Permissions

Copies of any letters granting permission to reproduce illustrations or tables from other sources, or lengthy quoted passages, must be included with the manuscript.

5. Proofs

Authors are asked to check their manuscripts *very carefully* before submitting them in order to prevent delays and extra costs at proofing. Authors will receive PDF proofs for correction which must be returned by dates given in the publication schedule.

6. Offprints

Upon publication, authors will receive electronic offprints (in PDF format) of their contribution. Guest editors of special issues will receive complimentary print copies of the issue.
