New subject areas *Medicine & Sciences* und *Medical Dictionaries*

From 1, January 2004 de Gruyter Publishers are re-organising the subject area *Scientific Periodicals* and the programme area *Medicine and Science* as two new subject areas - *Medicine and Sciences* and *Medical Dictionaries*.

With the exception of the dictionaries, the previous areas are being amalgamated as the subject area *Medicine & Sciences* under the management of **Wolfgang Böttner**. The section, employing 10 staff, publishes approx. 15 new books annually, together with 7 STM periodicals, the majority of them in English.

The subject area *Medical Dictionaries*, which includes i.a. the editing of the Pschtrembel works, is led by **Dr. Martina Bach**. The section employs 11 staff.

Dr. Josef Kleine, who previously led the section *Medicine and Sciences* as Programme Manager, is leaving de Gruyter after 20 years to take on new challenges.
