Ranging from the early 17th century to 1995, the three microfiche editions *Archivo Biográfico de España, Portugal e Iberoamérica (ABEPI) I, II* and *III* contain biographical entries from 866 reference works, comprising a total of 2,000 volumes. Biographical encyclopedias and handbooks, scattered all over the world, were utilized for this project.

Consisting of 2,633 microfiches, *ABEPI I, II* and *III* provide a unique overview of the cultural, economic and social phenomena, which have shaped the life and history of Spain, Portugal and Latin America. The Archives facilitate access to some 480,000 biographical entries, providing information on 340,000 individuals.



The *Archivo Biográfico de España, Portugal e Iberoamérica hasta 2001 (ABEPI IV)* has been designed not only as a supplement to the previous three parts but also as an independent work based upon up-to-date biographical reference works, thus focusing on contemporary personalities.

In over 200,000 biographical articles, *ABEPI IV* provides details on some 156,000 individuals from Spain, Portugal and Latin America. The articles are based on approximately 264 biographical reference works in 351 volumes, published between 1981 and 2001.

In addition to Spain and Portugal (with roughly 29% of the data), the source works included cover the following countries: Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Columbia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Guatemala, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua, Paraguay, Peru, Puerto Rico, Uruguay and Venezuela.

The lives of men and women from the world of arts, music, science, sports and business provide a multi-faceted view of contemporary Spain, Portugal and Latin America.

Although the *ABEPI IV* places special emphasis on representatives from the political and literary scenes it also encompasses biographies of directors, producers, actors and actresses. Among the individuals listed are Javier Solana Madariaga, Rigoberta Menchu, Rafael Alberti, Miguel Angel Asturias, Victoria Abril and Maria Luisa Bemberg, to name but a few.

In the course of twenty years, the Biographical Archives have become invaluable biographical reference tools used – and esteemed for their extensive scope – by academics, librarians, archivists, researchers and private individuals alike.

Continuing this great tradition, *Archivo Biográfico de España, Portugal e Iberoamérica hasta 2001* provides unlimited access to up-to-date biographical information on the Spanish- and Portuguese-speaking world.

This publication is of outstanding value for anybody researching into Spanish, Portuguese and Latin American history, politics, literature and genealogy.

C Martínez i Vendrell, Maria
(B. 1940, Barcelona- .) Writer of children's literature and educational material.

With a degree in psychology and education from the University of Barcelona, Maria Martínez i Vendrell works with teachers outside of the school. She is concerned particularly with the effect of the first year of school on a child's life and has contributed preschool material to the collection *Pensament i llenguatge* (Thought and language). In 1986 she undertook an interview project with Angeleta Ferrer, the daughter of Rosa Sensat; the result of these conversations is the book *Angeleta Ferrer: Maria Martínez*.

Martínez's stories for small children deal with a child's daily problems, such as fear of the dark, jealousy over a new baby in the house, and dread of going to the doctor. Written in a calm tone, the works minimize the drama of disturbing situations. Some of the stories are illustrated by Carme Solé. In 1983 Martínez won the Apel·les Mestres prize for the book *Jo les volia* (I wanted them), which tells about the death of a woman from the point of view of her seven-year-old daughter.

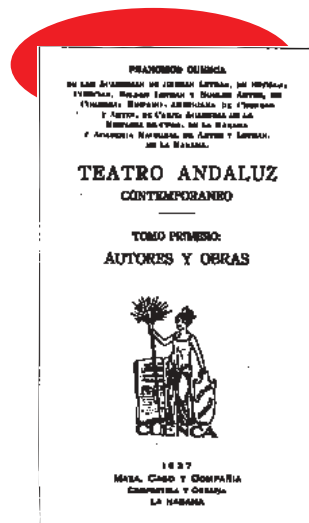
The new series of Archivo Biográfico de España, Portugal e Iberoamérica comprises biographical reference works from the mid-19th century to the 1950's. 333 evaluated sources in 961 volumes document this era which is of great importance to the history of Spain, Portugal and Latin America. In total, the new series contains approximately 204,000 articles, many of them accompanied by illustrations or portraits.

The selection of the biographical information contained in *ABEPI II* not only supplements the information on individuals already listed in *ABEPI* but also introduces thousands of newly incorporated personalities from the first half of the 20th century.

ABEPI II contains biographical material on individuals from the most important Spanish and Portuguese cities, a number of special works on individuals from the provinces as well as general biographical reference works on the Spanish Peninsula, the Balearic Islands, the Canaries and Ibero-America. The Spanish and Portuguese world is covered by roughly 50% of the source material, the second half is dedicated to the "biography" of Latin America.

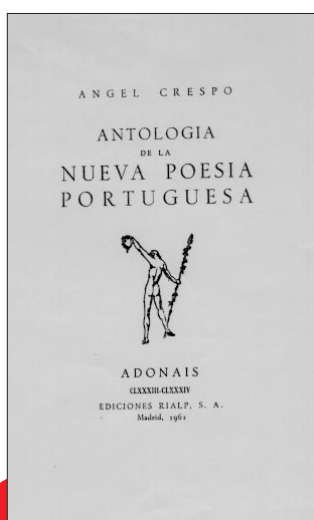

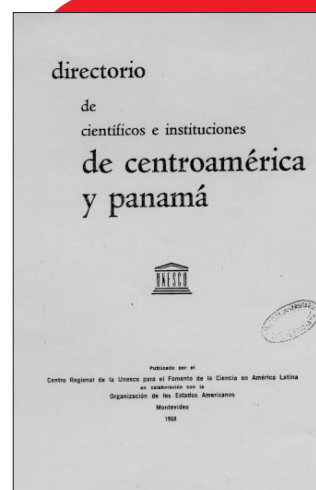
orship in 1989, are illustrated through the biographies of people who lived during those times or were involved in these events.
