Aims and Scope:


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Next to the proposals for thematic clusters and special issues, the journal also invites independent articles by both eminent and emerging scholars. After an initial editorial screening, submissions undergo a blind review process by an international advisory board and other experts in the field.

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Submissions prepared in Word format and MLA Referencing Style should be sent to the editorial office of arcadia, Ivana Perica (ivana.perica@univie.ac.at). The arcadia Style Sheet is available at http://www.degruyter.com/view/j/arca. Submitted papers should contain between 20 000 and 60 000 characters. They should not be submitted elsewhere, should not constitute chapters of finished or nearly finished dissertations, and should not have been published in another major language. Articles may be written in German, English, and French. Authors whose articles are not in their native language are strongly advised to have their manuscript checked by a native speaker. Stylistically and grammatically incorrect articles will not be considered.



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
