Most of the chapters collected here were presented as papers at the conference “Polemical Encounters: Polemics between Christians, Jews, and Muslims in Iberia and Beyond,” which took place at the Consejo Superior de Investigaciones Científicas (CSIC) in Madrid in October 2014. This conference was organized by the editors of this volume under the auspices of the European Research Council’s Advanced Grant project, European Union’s Seventh Framework Programme (FP7/2007–13) / ERC Grant Agreement 323316, project CORPI (“Conversion, Overlapping Religiosities, Polemics, Interaction: Early Modern Iberia and Beyond”), led by Principal Investigator Mercedes García-Arenal. Other chapters included here were presented afterward at the monthly CORPI seminar and added to the volume. Another collection of essays that grew out of the same conference has been published as a special issue of the journal *Medieval Encounters* (vol. 24, 2018) dedicated to “Interreligious Encounters in Polemics between Christians, Muslims and Jews in Iberia and Beyond” and is complementary to the present volume: for this issue, we chose the essays dedicated to the dialogical aspects of polemics, while in the present book, we focus on aggressive texts that aim at rising barricades between religious groups. CORPI has produced another book that also deals, in part, with polemics: *After Conversion: Iberia and the Emergence of Modernity*, edited by Mercedes García-Arenal and published in Leiden by Brill in 2016.
