

## EBR Spellings and Capitalizations

For further spelling examples, see B. J. Collins et al. (eds.), *The SBL Handbook of Style* (Atlanta, Ga. 2014) § 4.3.6. (p. 37-52).

BUT note that differences exist between EBR and SBL spellings.

### A) Basic Rules

- *Spelling of biblical names* should follow the *New Revised Standard Version (NRSV)*.
- *Spelling of non-biblical names* should follow “common usage” (check with editors) and/or “Merriam-Webster” online dictionary ([www.merriam-webster.com/dictionary](http://www.merriam-webster.com/dictionary)).
- *Arabic names with “al-”* should retain this in their short form (e.g., always “al-Tabari”, not “Tabari”).
- *Genitive of words ending in “s”* have apostrophe only (e.g., “Abraham’s horse” but “Amos’ horse”).
- *Note use and absence of hyphen* (e.g., “in the 17th century” but “in the 17th-century texts”).
