Primary Source Online



For the first time, the database offers the complete, unabridged, edited diaries of Victor Klemperer, the chronicler of 20th century German history. From 1918 until 1959, as the “cultural historiographer of the catastrophe,” the Romance philologist and converted Jew chronicled the process of disenfranchisement of the Jews and at the same time documented day-to-day life from the time of the Weimar Republic until the early days of the DDR.
