Online editions now on degruyter.com

As of July, subscribers to online editions will be able to access these versions at degruyter.com. Should these customers already have other online subscriptions at De Gruyter, the content will be automatically added to their accounts. If these are **new customers from libraries or other organizations**, they will have to tell us the IP addresses that we require in order to activate the content (send an email to orders@degruyter.com). We've already created accounts for **new private customers** under the email addresses they provided. These customers will have to request a new password associated with their email addresses by using the "Forgot password" function (www.degruyter.com/forgotpassword). The passwords and email addresses will allow them to log in to De Gruyter online and access the content. Information on 2017 annual subscriptions

In the future, we'll be offering three different options: Print only, online only and print + online. The list attached shows what option we've chosen for your subscription from 2017 onwards.

In the future, customers will also have the option to subscribe to an online-only version, which is why the print + online option will be slightly more expensive. From July, the online editions will include the following improvements:

- Articles in HTML and PDF formats with possibility of citation exports
- Access to all available issues back until 1995
- Usage statistics for all content (in COUNTER format)
- Secure archiving of all online content via Portico's service (portico.org)

Please also note that **the billing system will change** beginning with **2017 annual subscriptions onwards**. In the future you will be sent a bill before the annual subscription commences. Therefore, you'll receive the bill for 2017 subscriptions in late fall 2016. **De Gruyter's Terms and Conditions** will also apply from 2017. In 2016 the journals' formats and prices, invoicing and the Terms and Conditions will remain unchanged. The aforementioned changes won't apply until the 2017 annual subscription.
