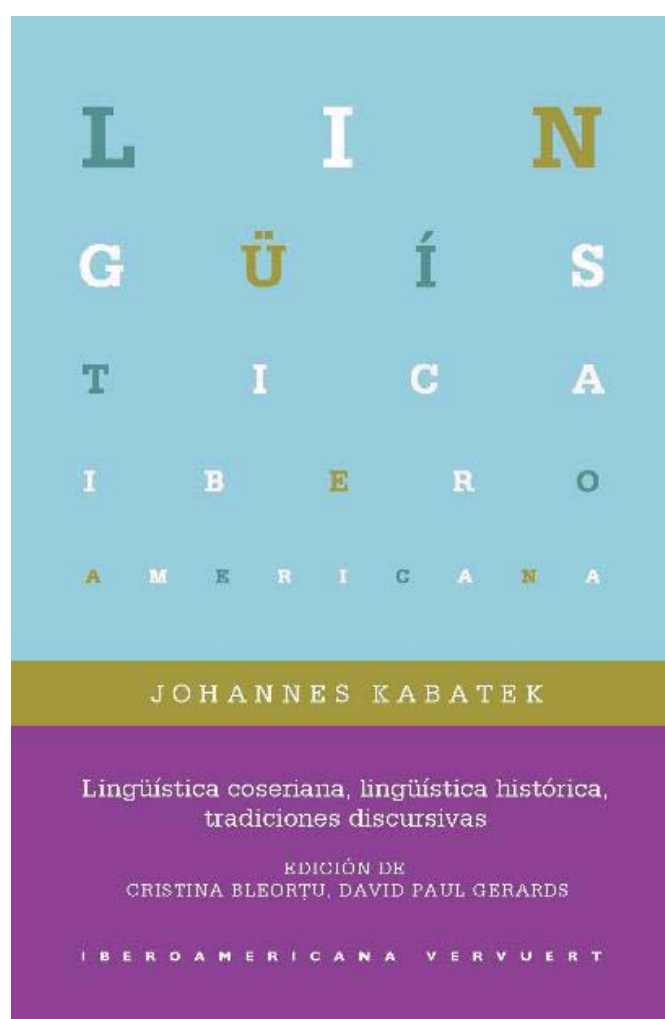


IBEROAMERICANA VERVUERT

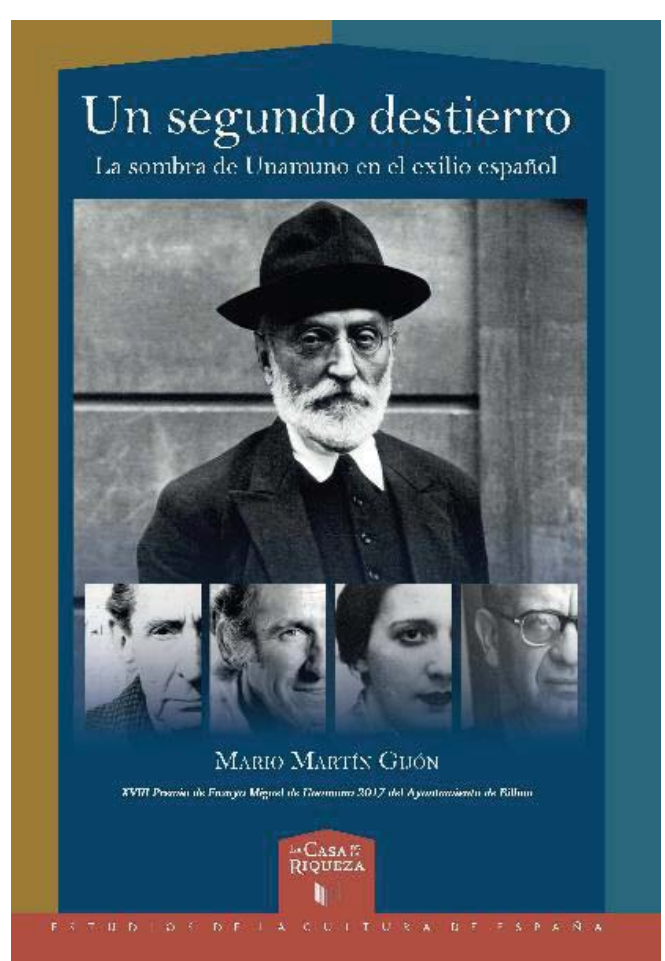
- History and Criticism of Spanish-Language Literature
