

Article Processing Charges

In order to sustain the production of our fully-refereed open access journal, each article accepted for publication in *Energy Harvesting and Systems* is subject to an Article Processing Charge.

For articles submitted by the end of 2023, the standard APC will be **€1000**. For articles submitted since January 2024, the standard APC will be **€1200**. Other fee reductions are available - see below.

This fee is used to cover the costs of the peer-review process, professional typesetting and copyediting, as well as online hosting, long-term preservation, distribution to libraries and content aggregators worldwide, and extensive promotion to potential readers.

All Authors are encouraged to apply for a **waiver or a discount** due to the Journal's extensive waiver and discount policy. All inquiries concerning Article Processing Charges should be addressed **before or immediately after submission of a paper** to the Editorial Office at ans.editorial@degruyter.com, so the waivers/further discounts can be reserved in advance.

Information regarding payment of these charges will be provided following acceptance for publication. There are no submission charges – Article Processing Charges apply after the acceptance of a manuscript.

Reviewers are not involved in author payment process and do not discuss charges with authors. The ability to pay does not influence whether or not a manuscript is accepted for publication.

Waiver Policies

If the submitting author is affiliated with an organization which is listed as an [Institutional Member](#) or which entered an [agreement](#) with De Gruyter, the author may be eligible for a reduced expense. Moreover, the authors who work for institutions in developing countries (countries classified by the World Bank as low-income and lower-middle-income economies) may apply for a waiver. Other authors who do not fulfil these criteria can request a discount during the submission process.
