The maximum length for articles is 8,000 words including tables, figures, notes and references. Exceptions may be made by the Editor-in-chief in *very rare cases*.

Authors should refer to the De Gruyter Mouton journal style sheet especially regarding the proper format for citations and reference entries. ***All submissions that do not comply with this style sheet will be returned to the author.***

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
