#### “Human Rights in Turkey: The Impact of the AKP”

We will consider publishing methodologically and empirically strong papers on a range of human rights topics, but we are particularly interested in papers addressing the following questions:

- Which areas of human rights in Turkey have progressed and which have regressed under the AKP rule?
- What does progress or regress (or both) of human rights in Turkey under the AKP tell us about Islam, Islamic politics, and human rights in general?
- How have human rights organizations in Turkey worked under the AKP rule?
- How has external factors influenced the AKP’s human rights policies?
- What do the AKP leaders think about human rights?
