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The *Review of Economics* publishes peer reviewed articles. It is necessary to agree upon standards of expected ethical behavior for all parties involved in the act of publishing: the author, the journal editor, the peer reviewer and the publisher. Our ethic statements are based on [COPE's](#) Best Practice Guidelines for Journal Editors.

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The editor of the *Review of Economics* is responsible for deciding which of the articles submitted to the journal are published. The editor may be guided by the policies of the journal's editorial board and constrained by such legal requirements as shall then be in force regarding libel, copyright infringement and plagiarism. The editor may confer with other editors or reviewers in making this decision.
