Article Processing Charges

Open Theology introduces publishing charges for the articles published since January 1, 2017.

Regular articles (published out of topical issues) submitted since September the 1st, 2016 may be considered only for paid publication. With regard to articles proposed for topical issues, authors are asked to check the information concerning payments in call for papers for the particular issue.

Regular fee for publishing an article is €500. It is used to cover the costs of the peer-review process, professional typesetting and copyediting, as well as online hosting, long-term preservation, distribution to libraries and content aggregators worldwide, and extensive promotion to potential readers.

Waiver Policies

If the submitting author is affiliated with an organization which is listed as an <u>Institutional Member</u>, this membership covers the cost of the Article Processing Charge and the author is exempt of any further expenses. Moreover, authors who work for institutions in developing countries (countries classified by the World Bank as <u>low-income</u> and <u>lower-middle-income</u> economies) can apply for a waiver.

Other authors who would like to apply for discounts or free publication are asked to discuss it with Managing Editor of the journal before submitting their article.
